May Allah bless you and keep you.

I am writing these letters to inform you of the new revelations that Allah, God, has allowed us to recognise today even though they were written thousands of years ago. They tell of our personal betrayal of Him before our first death.

At this time, Allah has said, by the hand of His messenger, that the Bible is a book of light. Likewise, the Holy Qur'an does not contradict itself when in some of its verses it speaks of the good fate that awaits Christians, Jews and Sabeans who do good, and in others it announces the fight against the infidel. In the absolute belief that Allah is just and merciful, and in the knowledge that a woman can never be unfaithful to a man she does not know, we can identify a little better those infidels of whom the Holy Qur'an speaks, for Allah is never capricious or arbitrary. Thus, these verses that speak of the infidels are addressed to those of the Muslim nation who disown Allah, rather to those who lead others astray from His path. Sometimes it even seems to refer to the demons who whisper in our ears free of body to divert us from the straight path in the right direction and against whose temptations we must fight (jihad); today they are the only ones who twist our destiny, for no one forces us to renounce our faith. In any case, Allah uses these verses to delimit our paths and to prevent any of us from going astray (that is His will, rather, for He has made us free; He does not want slaves, for with the blink of an eye He would bring the whole world to His praise).

Thus, these revelations, which I will detail concretely later, **are not opinion**, **nor belief or faith**, **but the logic of the world understandable to the unbelievers** who surround us everywhere today. Although it may seem **impossible**, this revelation confirms the Muslim faith as well as the Christian faith and some others. The reason why Allah has made things this way is because each of us was of an "age" so to speak, when we committed treason in paradise, which led to the first death. Here below, Allah, in His mercy, will ask of us the minimum to recover, to prove our faithfulness now. Just as in school (or in general) a 6 year old is not required the same as a 14 year old, He has made parallel paths in the right direction; <u>all of them guided by mercy</u> and adapted to that minimum for each nation. If you were born in the Muslim nation it is because **that is the path that will lead you to salvation** and to walk any other path would almost certainly have led you to eternal damnation.

I continue to detail the differences between Muslims and Christians, as it is important to understand these revelations (rather to understand why Allah has set different paths for different nations). The Christian also feels Allah within himself and calls Him the Holy Spirit, describing Him as the one who enables you to live happily above the sickness and sufferings of the world. Sakina or Holy tranquillity is the effect the Muslim feels when he harbours Allah within himself. In reality, it is the same and the effects are the same. For the Christian, 'Isa is not another little god; he is the one through whose innermost being flows that Holy Spirit in maximum intensity. Just as all of us (those listening) can feel Allah within us: some days with more intensity than others, there is also a maximum intensity. It may not yet be clear to them that 'Isa is the direct creation of Allah, although the name "son" already implies the creation of the Father; in this sense, since all souls are considered to be the creation of Allah, the Christian considers 'Isa to be his brother in creation. Indeed, 'Isa is also differentiated in the Holy Qur'an (he is not born of man, nor does he die). All this is important because **of what was revealed in the Bible that was hidden until today, which is roughly as follows:**

The serpent, Iblis, Shaitan. Designates the one who in Paradise started the rebellion because he wished to be as much or more than Allah and to take for himself from His Essence (tree of life). He hated and convinced others who hated because they could not be like Allah.

Eva. Designates those who believed Iblis and coveted that Essence, though they did not hate. They convinced their partner.

Adam. Designates those who betrayed as well, but it was not out of covetousness but out of love for their partner (Eve).

All of us have participated in the sin of paradise, and it drove us out. It is not a sin of our fathers (although we have been taught to keep it a secret until today). Allah is just and merciful.

But Allah became present and put an end to the rebellion. When He was about to eliminate Iblis and his people, Iblis said to Him, "The Adams have betrayed you too, if you kill me, kill them too, or are you not the righteous par excellence?"

Allah is the One Who Is. He cannot deny Himself. He thought of a new nature to save us, making it all new, and that it might escape the old righteousness. To do this, the first of Allah's creation, 'Isa, had to pass the test in the new nature. Thus he made it fit for all mankind, for if he who tested the heavenly nature (the same as Iblis), were to test the human nature, neither Iblis nor any other angel could declare it unrighteous, for that would be to declare his own nature unrighteous as well.

This is not believed by Christians, nor Muslims, but it is all revealed in the Bible. We were created in the beginning as angels, before the betrayal (!?!?. -Yes, it sounds crazy and it hurts the ears just to say it, but you will see that it is true). As men we have a new opportunity to show our faithfulness to God.

The evidence is in DANIEL, GENESIS, APOCALYPSE and others. They describe our salvation history in three and a half times (1st in paradise full of Allah before the betrayal, 2nd with Allah but empty of Him not yet on earth, 3rd on earth as men before Isa and last half time here too after Isa).

Well, these are not Christian beliefs, even if they are in the Bible. And even though Isa is a key piece, it gives unquestionable veracity to the Muslim faith as well. For we cannot separate ourselves from the path that Allah has set for our salvation. However, there are important things to be deduced from all this:

There are fools in the world who do not listen to Allah. These are in every nation (Christian, Muslim,...) and they are usually in every family. They are the Eves who listened to Iblis in heaven and here, in justice, they will not have ears for Allah, God, but they will have ears for Iblis and the world. But it is written: at the end of time we will all be united. This means that they too will be able to see Alláh, God. And they will be able to do so by the logic of the world, because what was revealed was hidden for thousands of years in different generations of different nations who wrote in the Bible. It is impossible for it to have been passed on from one to another by the mouth of man. It could only have been written by Allah, God, since no one knew what he was actually writing about; this too the fool will see.

All this, which seems madness, is explained at <u>www.logicandgod.com</u> (it has no advertising or user tracking or anything like that).

So great is what has been revealed that I, being a Christian, can say that Allah is the only God and Mohammed is His Messenger; and I am still a Christian, just as when you see what has been revealed you will still be a Muslim. But it is important to spread the knowledge about Allah to help all the fools who cannot listen to Him (also in your environment: those who call themselves Muslims without being Muslims, and say it for appearances in front of others) and also for those who do not understand that Allah being just and merciful wants us to be equally just and merciful. It is important to know that Iblis, the enemy, is the father of hatred, and he who hates will come to an end with him (the worst sadist who wants to destroy us and uses our pain to try to harm God who loves us).

The world is coming to an end and this revelation is a sign that this is so.

Do not shy away from communicating this to those who promote mosques in the West, for even the one who is most willing to draw near to Allah will end up in hell, an-nar, if he is guided by hatred. The more we know about the nature of Allah our God, the better we will understand His ways and the easier it will be for all to reach the destination; separate (though parallel and similar) paths and the same destination.
